
The Dragon Boat Festival

The Dragon Boat Festival is also called the Duanwu Festival. It is on May 5th of the Chinese lunar calendar. We eat *zongzi* and race dragon boats to honour the great poet, Qu Yuan . *Zongzi* is a pyramid-shaped dumpling. A dragon boat is like a dragon and painted in red, white, yellow and black.
